### Gravestones:

Approximately fifty gravestones were cleaned. Gary and Wesley wet each with water. John F. and John K. then sprayed them with D2.

The monument of L. H. Jacobs was re-leveled. Wesley, Clay, and Ryland applied more soil underneath to level the stone.

A marker piece for George Seeligson and one for David Vance was secured to new concrete pads. The pads were built the day before by Gary and Joe D. Mary Belle and Gary mixed sand and mortar. Joe D. and Ryland spread the mixture on each pad then secured each piece on their respective pads.

### Grounds Maintenance:

The county continues to mow the cemetery. The grounds looked good at this time. The road to and around the cemetery remains accessible. John Kassner put ant powder on numerous ant mounds. Mary Belle provided the powder.
